CV Abstract:

PR is primarily an observational astrophysicist working in the field of cosmology, with a broad and deep expertise in multi-wavelength surveys, as well as in imaging and spectroscopic studies in the optical-IR and X-ray bands of distant galaxy clusters, distant galaxies and Active-Galactic Nuclei. In his early carrier, primarily spent at Johns Hopkins University (Baltimore, USA), he constructed the then largest sample of distant X-ray selected galaxy clusters (the ROSAT Deep Cluster Survey, RDCS) and used these data to constrain cluster evolution and cosmological parameters. He had a co-leading role in the Chandra Deep Field South (CDF-S) project by planning the X-ray survey, carrying out a multi-wavelength program of source identification and publishing the first scientific results. He led the ESO-GOODS public survey in the context of the Great Observatories Origins Deep Survey (GOODS) project, designed to study galaxy formation and evolution over a wide range of cosmic lookback time. He led several studies of the most distant galaxy clusters – particularly with HST/ACS, Chandra and two VLT Large Programmes – investigating their galaxy populations and mass distributions with lensing and dynamical techniques. He was involved in the definition of the Euclid mission as a member of the ESA Science Study Team. He is currently engaged in a new study of the dark matter distribution in massive clusters and distant primordial galaxies exploiting strong gravitational lensing. As a staff astronomer at ESO, he was the deputy of the VLT Programme Scientist, carrying out the science verification of the first generation VLT instruments; he led the Advanced Data Products group, the Hubble Legacy Archive group in the Space Telescope European Coordinating Facility, and was Instrument Scientist of the VLT survey spectrographs. Since Sept 2013 is full professor in Astrophysics at University of Ferrara (Italy).
